About the School

Start classes any Monday year round for any number of weeks from 1 to 24. Calendar (open during Christmas holidays): No makeup days or classes held on official holidays. Activities

Connecting the culture to the language is an important component of your program. There is a regular program of social activities including welcome cocktail parties, conversation exchange evenings with Mexican students studying English, and lectures on different aspects of Mexican and Mayan culture. The school also organizes excursions to some of the region's most interesting locations such as the ancient Mayan cities of Tulúm and Chichén Itzá, the coral reefs of the island of Cozumel or one of the region's many superb nature reserves. These are at additional cost, but are kept reasonable. Other activities which can be arranged include diving lessons, golf classes, Mexican cooking courses, and bicycle and car rentals.

Courses and Descriptions

Intensive group course - 4 hours daily of class M-F with an average of 6 people in a class (maximum of 8) with formation of groups based on all levels, from beginners to advanced.

Intensive + 2 private - 4 hours daily of group classes M-F with an additional 2 private classes daily.

Intensive + cooking course - 1 to 4 week course. 4 hours daily of group classes M-F and daily cooking courses.

Intensive + Latin dancing - Four hours daily M-F of group Spanish lessons and daily dancing you will enjoy an assortment of Latin dancing lessons from our expert dance instructors. Learn the Cha Cha Cha, Salsa, Rumba, Samba.

Spanish + Discover Mexico - Daily afternoon classes are designed to give students an insight into the immensely rich Mexican culture. Topics covered include the history or Mexico, regional and ethnic diversity, folklore, the arts, etc., and class activities are designed primarily to help students develop their communicative skills.

Spanish + Volunteer Work

Make a difference by taking part of a social project by volunteering with your teacher. The local animal shelter is a favorite among students. This is a course that you can add on by the day. Two hours daily 4 to 6pm.

Style of teaching

All teachers have university degrees and have received specialized training in the teaching of Spanish to foreigners. Levels offered

Maximum group size 5, but averages only 2-3. Private classes available. Classes 9 am - 2pm.

Students

Participants in the programs of IH Riviera Maya come from many backgrounds and parts of the world and are of all ages. The minimum age to study is 16, but an exception is made for families with children under 16 who are studying with their family.

All levels of Spanish are accommodated, from complete beginners to those with advanced levels. You will be placed in a class of your same level.

Although most people travel unaccompanied, we often accommodate couples, families, and groups of friends. This diversity creates a very interesting and stimulating environment for all.

Accommodations

All lodging starts on Sunday evening and ends on Saturday morning. Extra nights can normally be arranged.

School Residence Hall- Highly recommended by Language Link

The residence hall is located in the center of Playa del Carmen, on a very quiet street, beside the town's main church and just two blocks (a 5-minute walk) from the school. The residence has three floors and a lower level. The ground floor consists of the reception desk, an office, the kitchen and 6 bedrooms. There are 10 bedrooms on the first floor and the second floor has 6 bedrooms and four terraces.

All bedrooms have twin beds and each bedroom has its own private bathroom. Bedrooms also have a desk, a TV, ceiling fans and air-conditioning, as well as a small refrigerator.

You can choose between bed and breakfast and half board (evening meal) or no meals. Note that meals are served in the residence hall.
