Arrive and depart from Aeropuerto Internacional Benito Juárez (MEX).

A second new airport is in Mexico City farther away from the city, Felipe Ángeles International Airport (NLU) and without consistent transport to Cuernavaca. In Benito Juárez there are direct buses to Cuernavaca.


