Airport

Fly into Liberia International Airport. Pickup is available at a cost for the two hour drive to Sámara Beach. An alternative is to fly into the San José International Airport. There is shuttle service and a public bus between San José and Sámara Beach (4.5 hours) or private taxi option. The school provides a variety of transport packages including an overnight stay in San José.

About Costa Rica

This nation of 3.8 million people has long been popular with Spanish students, thanks to its outstanding natural beauty and political stability. The friendliness of the Costa Rican people and the clarity of their accent make this lovely country a particularly good choice to explore a Spanish-speaking society.

Since dismantling its army in 1948, Costa Rica has turned its resources toward developing a peaceful and healthy society. Known as the "Switzerland of Latin America," Costa Rica continues to invest in democratic institutions and lead peace initiatives. It boasts one of the highest literacy rates in Latin America, and its people enjoy greater life expectancy and health care than those in neighboring nations.

Geographically, Costa Rica is slightly smaller than the state of West Virginia. Costa Rica supports nearly 5% of the species known to the world and has converted nearly one-quarter of its land to protected conservation areas. Within the thirteen national parks and six biological reserves, you can encounter a staggering array of plants and animals, including monkeys, sloths, armadillos, jaguars, and tapirs, vast numbers of amphibians and reptiles, and more than 800 different species of butterflies. Costa Rica is the ideal spot for students interested in outdoor adventure or conservation.

The country's extraordinary emphasis on the value of education means that it has some of the best teachers available in Latin America. The high standard of living brings you safe drinking water, and reliable and easily accessible communication. It's a beautiful country with an amazing natural variety. You can spend weekends lounging on beautiful beaches or in tropical lodges open to the sounds of the jungle. Or you can try something more active like hiking through cloud forests, rafting wild rivers or mountain biking through lush mountains. Or you may want to see an active volcano shooting lava into the night.

Most of all, it's the warmth and gentleness of the people which appeals to travelers and students. The local people are called ticos, and the national slogan is Pura Vida. That says it all, as the closest equivalent is "This is the life!"

About Sámara Beach

In the area of Guanacaste on the sun-drenched Pacific coast of Costa Rica, the sleepy town of Sámara Beach or Playa Sámara is a horseshoe bay boasting what Frommer's calls "the most beautiful beach in the Costa Rica." It is the perfect long white sand beach with shallow, gentle waters and sheltered by palm trees. The seemingly endless beach affords excellent swimming in an ideal warm temperature, surfing, kayaking, snorkeling, birdwatching, and beyond the coral reef - fine deep water fishing. CNN proclaimed: "Forget Disneyland! Costa Rica is the happiest place in the world."

The town of Sámara Beach itself is tranquil and easy-going, but it has everything a visitor could want: a well stocked supermarket, regular vegetable and fish marts, pharmacies, a variety of restaurants, convenience stores, bars, hotels, gym, spa, and two banks with ATMs. The town is not only a charming beach resort, but it is also a thriving fishing and farming community. There are cowboys, and cattle drives, fishing boats returning at sunset, exotic fruit harvests, organic farming, and tree nurseries.

Sámara's laidback vibe allows for rest and relaxation, an almost universal characteristic of the Nicoya Peninsula. There is magic in every sunset when you can sit under a palm tree, feel the ocean breeze and hear the sound of the waves. On some clear evenings there is a small green light, which shows for an extremely short moment, just before the sun disappears. A very short instant that you will remember for a long time. It is an everyday, but unique sunset show.

It is the perfect example of Pura Vida, the Costa Rican phrase which expresses a philosophy of strong community, good spirits, enjoying life slowly, and celebrating good fortune, whether small or large. Sámara Beach is a quiet place where the traditional culture of Costa Rica is not lost, and it is a perfect place to relax and study Spanish.

Students

The minimum age for formal classes is 18, although there is a teen program in summer and a kids camp for younger students in the summer months, and we also welcome teens in organized groups. Coming from all over the world, students' ages are in a complete range, with the majority of older students coming in fall and winter months.



All students receive a free tour as part of your welcome to Intercultura. There are also many complimentary activities included in the cost of your study. These include: Latin dance, yoga, crafts, Zumba, weekly cooking class, weekly music class, lectures and tertulias (informal gatherings), and twice a month film nights.

There are also half day tours and full weekend excursions tours offered for a fee.

Style of Teaching

The primary goal of Intercultura is to teach you the Spanish language in a warm yet intellectually challenging environment. Classes are conducted entirely in Spanish, providing students with a complete and intensive learning experience. Intercultura's professors have advanced university degrees and teaching certification, as well as being native Spanish speakers. The Communicative Approach which is used actively engages the learner in the class-room. This system of teaching puts the focus of learning on the learner, meaning that he or she is an engaged and active participant in the language acquisition process. Students learn to speak in meaningful, real life situations.

Levels Offered

All levels of Spanish ability are welcome, from complete beginners to very advanced. You will have both a written and speaking evaluation at the beginning of your course to ensure proper placement.

Class Size and Hours

The maximum number of students per class is 6. Private classes are available except for summer months. Classes are held on an alternating morning-afternoon schedule to allow you lots of beach time!

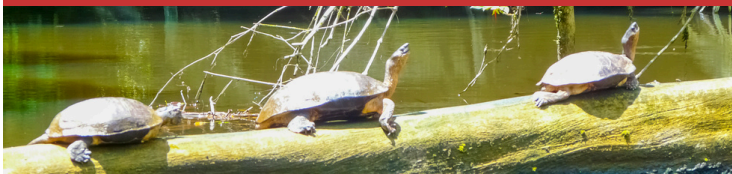

These options cannot be pre-booked, as they vary throughout the year depending on what is going on in the Sámara community at any given time.

VOLUNTEERING WITH ANIMALS

Wildlife and Conservation

Work at a turtle refuge, volcano national park or animal rescue center.

Experience Costa Rican nature by working and living in a remote but beautiful area, where life is simple and your memories priceless. We have several placements in stock and many of them are offered year-round.

Please note that you must study at least one week prior to volunteering, have a basic grasp of the language and there is a placement fee.

COURSES

- Group – four daily hours M-F in group of maximum 6
- Group Plus One – 4hours daily of group + 1 hour daily of private, not available May through August
- Group Plus Two – 4hours daily of group + 2 hours daily of private, not available May through August
- All Private Four – 4 hours daily of private classes, content can be adapted to specific needs, not available May through August
- Children's Program for minors travelling with guardian: Indoor-Outdoor Spanish Camp Classes, 4 hrs/day, M-F. Dynamic, Active Learning Program
- Teen Summer Camp (13-17 years) 20 hrs group or 15 hrs private Spanish classes, homestay w/ 2 meals, volunteer placement, student advisor, cultural activities. Optional: tours (extra cost). All inclusive and supervised program.

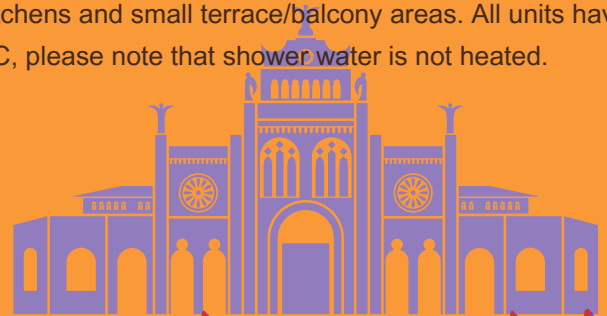
Your homestay includes two meals daily of breakfast and dinner, and laundry service is included. All homes are within walking distance, and you will have a private bedroom. Special diets such as vegetarian can be accommodated.
