CI and CE in Spain are pronounced as "th" instead of S, so plaza is said as platha, and gracias will sound like grathias. Barcelona becomes Barthelona. It's a very small change to which you can easily adjust. The Spanish which is taught in all our programs in Spain will be a standard, classic Spanish with grammar and vocabulary which will comfortably take you everywhere in the Spanish speaking world.

Many students fly into Madrid, and from there they take the high speed AVE train to Seville (2 hours). You can also fly directly into Seville. Airport pickup is available.

About Seville

If any one place comes close to rolling together everything that's quintessentially Andalusian, it's Seville. Here in the region's capital and biggest city, that special Andalusian way of life is distilled into its purest and most intense form. Seville has the most passionate and portentous Semana Santa, the most festive and romantic annual feria, the best tapas bars, the best nightlife and the most stylish people in Andalucía of southern Spain.

It has more narrow, winding, medieval lanes and romantic, hidden plazas soaked in the scent of orange blossoms than half of Andalucía's other cities put together. It's the home of the bulwark of Andalusian tradition, flamenco. Its heritage of art and architecture (Roman, Islamic, Gothic, Re-naissance, Baroque) is without rival in southern Spain.

But Seville's most developed art form is that of enjoying oneself. To be out at night among the city's relaxed, fun-loving crowds – in the tapas bars, on the streets, in the clubs and discos – is an experience you won't forget.

Seville can be best described as a city of colors. Everywhere you turn, there are flowers, orange trees, and multicolored tiles that complement the houses. The colorfulness of the city is not only reflected in the buildings and landscapes, but also in the people and their way of life.

Home to 600,000 residents, Seville, originally built by the Romans, is now a bustling city with its own airport and a bullet train called el AVE that gets you to Madrid in just over 2 hours. Seville has an astonishing number of palaces, churches, towers, and historic hospitals. Probably the most impressive of the sites is the Cathedral, located in the Plaza del Triunfo. Begun in the 1400's, it took centuries to complete. It is one of the world's largest cathedrals, comparable in size to St. Peter's in Rome.

A short walk from the Cathedral is the Alcázar, a 14th Century Mudéjar palace built by Pedro the Cruel. Today, the Alcázar is the Sevillian home of King Juan Carlos and Queen Sofía, making it the oldest royal European residence still in use.

But Seville's most developed art form is that of enjoying oneself. To be out at night among the city's relaxed, fun-loving crowds in the tapas bars and on the streets is an experience you won't forget.

Activities

Seville is an ideal place to experience the Spanish way of life due to the wide range of cultural activities that it can provide. High season pricing is more expensive and runs from June 2 to September 28.

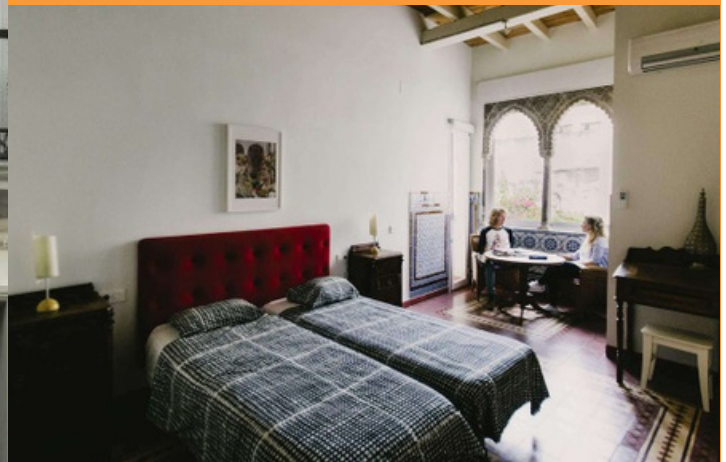
Double rooms are only available for students travelling together and displayed prices are per person.
