It's a very small change to which you can easily adjust. About San Sebastián

To visit San Sebastián, in the Basque country on Spain's northern coast, is to fall in love. The first sight of the shimmering bay, replete with crescents of golden sand and turquoise waves, will sweep you off your feet. Pairing this natural beauty with the unrivalled local cuisine, from Michelin starred feasts to bite sized pintxos (Basque tapas) may leave your head spinning.

The city will be putting its best foot forward for years, as it was named a 2016 European Capital of Culture. San Sebastián or Donostia in Basque is 20 km away from the border of France and on the coast of the Bay of Biscay. Not overly large, the city's population is about 200,000.

It is one of the most famous tourist destinations in Spain. There are many events which take place here, such as the International Film Festival and Jazz Festival, giving the city an international prestige. Meanwhile, the larger province blends sea and mountains, offering the traveler landscape, sports and cuisine, as well as interesting monuments.

A common question is about the language spoken in the Basque areas. Yes, there are two official languages – Basque (Euskara) and Spanish. Signs will be in both languages. About 30% of the population speaks Basque, but almost everyone speaks fluent Spanish.

The Basque language is a language isolate, not belonging to any language family but constituting its own language family. Grammatically, it is the most complex of any language in the world. Even many Basques who speak Spanish as a first language have extreme difficulty learning the language. What you will learn at the school is standard Spanish, and you will hear it everywhere and learn to speak a very useable Spanish. All the while, it's interesting to over- hear a snippet of conversation in Basque along the street.

In brief, San Sebastián is a beautiful, cosmopolitan city with a strong Basque character, and filled with cultural events. The fishing boat regatta tells us something of the tradition, while the prestigious film and jazz festivals say a great deal about its international allure. It's a fascinating place to study Spanish!

About The School
