About Cusco

Cusco (less preferred spelling Cuzco), the capital of the ancient Inca Empire, is the cultural heart of the Peruvian Andes and is a UNESCO designated World Heritage City. Situated at almost 11,000 feet in altitude and surrounded by dramatic mountains it has a population of 300,000 mostly indigenous inhabitants. It makes the perfect base for exploration of the country.

Cusco was founded around 1100 A.D. with its name meaning “the navel of the world”. After the conquest the Spanish built their colonial churches and houses on top of the Inca foundations, and this interesting architectural style is still evident. Imagine exploring the cobbled stone colonial alley ways with streets lined with original Inca walls and arches. Cusco remains a city of indigenous people with colorful markets and alpaca wool treasures. It totally offers a unique experience for Spanish students and discerning travelers.

Sacred Valley – runs with minimum of 8 people and must be booked with accommodation. Mandatory supplement fee of \$40 US to be paid before departure to school admin. 2026 Start dates March 16, April 20, May 18, Jun 22, Jul 6, Sept 28, Oct 26 (runs with minimum of 8 people).

If there are no group courses available at your Spanish level, Amauta will instead offer a reduced number of private hours for a single student and a higher number of semi-private hours for 2 students. Each class hour is 55 minutes of instruction.

Style of teaching

All courses are taught in the communicative method. All classes include the study of grammar in theory and practice, exercises to extend vocabulary and pronunciation, development of listening, writing and reading comprehension, techniques of oral communication, guided conversation and role play, and information on Peruvian culture and society. All teachers are native Spanish speakers and professionals who have been qualified under Amauta's teachers' course and participate in continuing education. They are committed to giving students the richest possible experience of Peruvian culture and customs. All teachers have been chosen because of their high quality teaching skills, their enthusiasm and their local knowledge of Cusco and Peru.

Levels offered

There are 12 levels offered which accommodate complete beginners to advanced speakers. All students come to school their first Monday morning at 8am to take a placement test which is multiple choice questions and a short oral test.

About the School

The Sacred Valley

Amauta's campus in the picturesque Sacred Valley of the Incas is an off-the-beaten-path location to learn Spanish. Get away from the city life of Cusco and experience the tranquility of traditional Peruvian life. The Sacred Valley puts you in the heart of Inca culture with easy access to some of Peru's most noted Inca ruins, including Ollantaytambo, Pisac, Chinchero, Maras and Moray. The Sacred Valley school is divided into sleeping/living and study areas. There are bedrooms, bathrooms, a kitchen, a dining room, spaces for the classes, and a lounge room— perfect for relaxing and studying. Located approximately 80 minutes by bus from Cusco, the Sacred valley boasts breathtaking views of snowy peaks, green valleys and picturesque houses. The climate is warmer than Cusco due to the lower altitude, and the people are exceptionally friendly.

Spanish lessons take place in either the morning or late afternoon, allowing time to explore by visiting Inca fortresses, markets, salt flats, cultivated Inca terraces, and more! In addition, the Sacred Valley gives you a chance to go walking, mountain biking, horseback riding, or four-wheeling.

A week in the Sacred Valley includes transportation from Cusco, accommodation in either double or single room, all meals, field trips and 4 hours per day (M-F) of group Spanish classes at all levels. 2026 Start dates March 16, April 20, May 18, Jun 22, Jul 6, Sept 28, Oct 26 (runs with minimum of 8 people).



Tambopata Rainforest

Experience the Amazon Basin of Peru in a tropical rainforest. Your all inclusive week's cost includes 4 hours daily of group Spanish classes, 6 nights of accommodation, all meals and daily excursions with a professional guide. Arrival from Cusco to Puerto Maldonado will be with the group on a night bus. Bus cost not included in the package, but cost upon request. **Suitable for all levels except complete beginners.** 2026 Start Dates April 28, May 26, Jun 30, Oct 6 (runs with minimum of 6 people).

Three Locations to Choose From

A unique feature of Amauta is that classes are offered in three different locations – Cusco with host family stays or school residence, the Sacred Valley with accommodations and board within the school, and an all inclusive program in Tambopata in the Amazon Jungle. You can remain in Cusco for your entire study or you can combine with one or more of the other locations. Please note that all the programs have specific start dates, and the costs are different in each. Also note that study in the Sacred Valley and Tambopata Rainforest locations require a minimum of 6 participants on any scheduled date. The school cannot guarantee that these programs will be a go until four weeks prior. We can keep you closely advised on the possibilities if you have interest in a location in addition to Cusco.

A special note here – if through the Amauta Dos Manos travel agency please keep your calendar in mind. We can book this for you along with your school reservation, but if you want to prebook a Machu Picchu train trip, reserve must be made at least 4 weeks in advance. To hike the Inca Trail, reserve must be made 4 – 6 months in advance.

Accommodations

Host Family

The families are carefully chosen and monitored through regular inspections and student feedback. The families that work with the school are middle class families. Most of them live about 25-35 minutes walking distance from the school and in these cases regular public transport (approx. every 10 minutes) is available.

Unfortunately, Cusco suffers from a chronic water shortage and most of the families do not have a water tank. Also hot water installations might not meet Western standards. You should take this situation into account. Host families provide two meals a day, breakfast (6:30am – 9:30am) and the main meal/lunch (1pm – 3.30pm). Generally, these times are flexible and the student may make other arrangements for meals if they wish. Special diets may be requested, such as vegetarian or diabetic, with advance notice. Vegans incur a special charge.

Homestay Plus

This package offers a slightly higher comfort level with larger rooms and a courtyard or garden. We can also request a private bath at this level, although they are limited in number. This is especially well suited for couples who wish to share a room and is especially recommended for older people.

Student Residence

This is located directly next to the school and is perfect for those who want contact with students from many different parts of the world. Single rooms, shared bathrooms or private, a terrace and a common kitchen/living room. The location is perfect, only a 2 minute walk from the Plaza de Armas. No meals.
