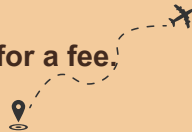

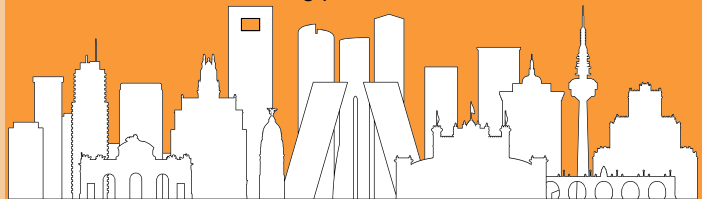

About The School

Courses and Descriptions

- Intensive Group – four hours daily of group no larger than 8
- Intensive 30 Group – six hours daily of group no larger than 8
- Combined Course A: Intensive Spanish classes (20 hours per week) + 1 private lesson of 55 minutes per day.
- Combined Course B: Intensive Spanish classes (20 hours per week) + 2 private lessons of 55 minutes per day
- Private Four – four hours daily of private one to one classes, can be customized for content. We recommend these classes if you have limited time and have a specific need.
- Private Six – six hours daily of private one to one classes, can be customized for content.
- 50+ Group + Culture – For more mature students, four hours of group class with very conversational, practical situation Spanish. Plus a daily activity of a cultural lecture or visit. Available only in the month of May and October, start dates any Monday in May and October, two weeks are recommended. May 5th to May 30th or October 6th to October 31st, 2025.

Cooking Classes are offered on Tuesday and Thursday, 4:15 – 5:45pm. Offered in two week blocks.

Dance classes of 90 minutes, at both beginner and advanced levels are offered in a variety of styles. Offered by style in two week blocks.

Every other weekend we offer an excursion to important cities near Madrid like Segovia, Toledo, Ávila, and La Granja.:

- El Escorial: The monastery built by Philip II in the 16th century.
- Aranjuez: The spring palace of the Spanish royalty.
- Chinchón: One of the most typical Castilian towns.
- Segovia: A city with a Roman aqueduct, a castle and a cathedral.
- La Granja: The summer palace of the Spanish royalty.
- El Pardo: The Royal Palace, former residence of Franco.
- Manzanares El Real: A Romantic castle in the mountains.
- Toledo: The seat of the Spanish court during the reign of Charles V. We'll visit the cathedral, the Santo Tomé Church, El Greco's house, San Juan de los Reyes and two medieval synagogues.
- Ávila: A Romanesque walled city. We'll visit the Plaza Mayor and some churches, and take a walk to experience the atmosphere within the walls.
